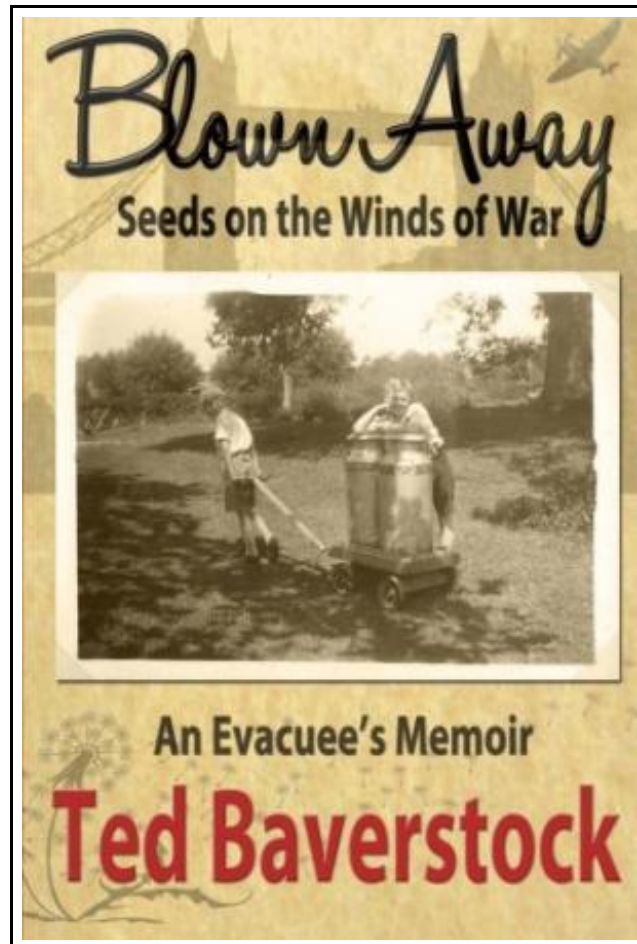

The hitherto secret government operation code-named Pied-Piper had begun. School assembly was held in the playground that morning. we were then shepherded in double file through the streets that we knew well, past our homes where mothers waved to us from their front doors. none of us knew the significance of the journey we were about to undertake or where we were bound.
