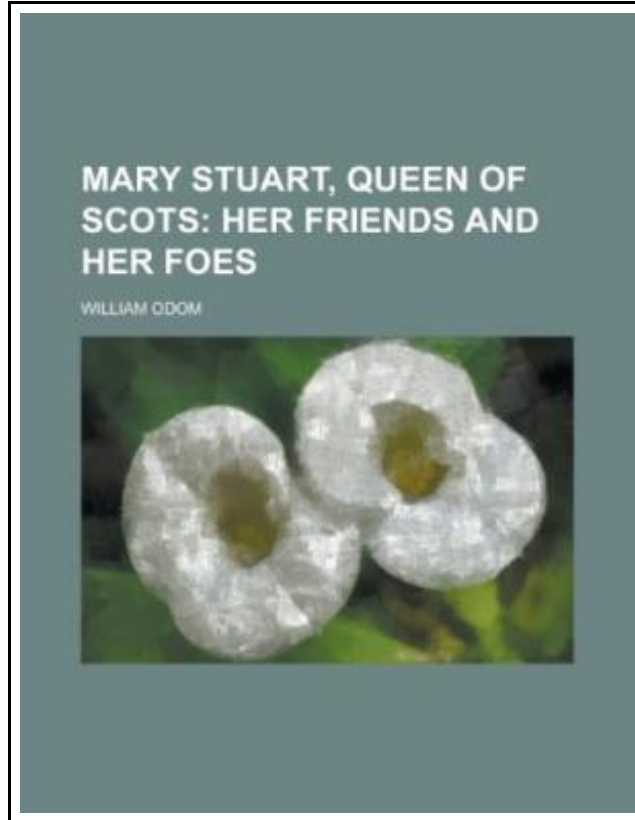

Our fault were not shameful; you have promised to be mine, and I yours; I believe the Queen of England and country should like of it. Letters between the two were frequent, she writing to him in cipher, which Higford one of his private secretaries deciphered and transcribed for the Duke. We learn that several of Mary's letters were smuggled into the Tower in ale bottles, the corks of which were marked, and that Norfolk's answers were returned the same way. During this year Mary's hopes were clouded, not only by the imprisonment of Norfolk, but also by the murder of her half-brother, the Regent Murray, in the streets of Linlithgow, as narrated in...
